Dear Mike,

The best way to resolve the conflict between us for me to give a developmental lesson on the existence of God to an audience of grown-up Catholic theologians and philosophers. In the give and take of a developmental lesson, the truth will come out.

The reason I reached out to the undergraduates at Columbia University is that the theology faculties at Fordham, St. John's, and Seton Hall refused to meet with me. I now have pending a request to give this lesson to the faculty and students at St. Joseph's Seminary in New York. This request has the support of the Director of the University Apostolate-Campus Ministry, Vincent DaSilva. I'd appreciate your contacting the Rector of St. Joseph's and recommend that my offer to give the lesson be accepted.

In the meantime, I've written up my lesson plan in the form of a survey/test and sent it to 98 theologians at Fordham, St. John's, and Seton Hall. I can't honestly say they all failed, because they refused to answer any of my questions. I am going to send the survey/test to the Magis Center. If the Magis Center answers the questions, I will tell you how good or how bad you did.

You and Mr. Busch should make an effort to understand the trouble the Magis Center has caused between me and the Archdiocese of New York. You are not working for a business. If you were, you would be right to defend the integrity of your boss. The letter I mailed to Cardinal Dolan explains why the conflict between me and the Archdiocese involves the welfare of minors.

Vincent DaSilva, who is the director of the University Apostolate-Campus Ministry, suggested that I present my ideas about the arguments for God's existence to the faculty of St. Joseph's Seminary in New York. I spoke to the Rector (Msg. Peter Vaccari), but have not gotten an invitation or a refusal. What on earth is going on? Why is no Catholic theologian willing to discuss this matter with me in person in a session of give and take?
