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Your fourth question has three parts. I agree with the first part (human beings are animals; we bear a common ancestry with all other animals); I disagree with the second part (we do not differ from other animals with respect to mere possession of freedom of will). I disagree with the third part (we do not differ from other animals with respect to mere possession of consciousness).

There is no way that I can convey this information by ticking one of the three responses that you allow.

As things stand, there is no way that you are going to get anything useful from responses to this question. (You can't tell whether people who agreed did so because they agreed with all of it, or only with part of it; you can't tell whether people who disagree did so because they disagreed with all of it, or only with part of it.)

Perhaps you might say: it's a conjunction. And a conjunction is only true when both of the conjuncts are true. So I should say it's false. But it's quite important (to me) that I think that the first conjunct is true.
